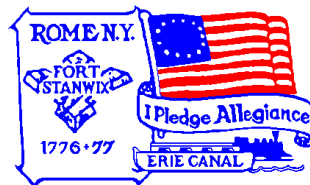
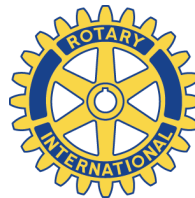

Canalfest has three different types of booth space available: vendors, clubs, and not-for-profits.

1) **Vendors** - Merchants wanting to sell or advertise goods or services. We are not accepting any new food vendors this year. The cost is \$75 per 10'x10' space.

2) **Clubs** - Groups wanting to promote their club or organization. No merchandise can be sold at this level. The cost is \$10 per 10'x10' space.

3) **Not-for-Profit** - Not-for-profit organizations. You will receive a 10'x10' space at no charge. No merchandise can be sold at this level.

**Things to bring:** tent(s), tables and chairs, lights, 100-foot extension cord to reach the available electricity and power Strip / Surge Protector.

**Security:** There will be a security person on site from Friday night after closing through Saturday morning at 7 am, and also on Saturday night after closing through Sunday at 7 am.

Once we receive your application and check, we will send you a receipt. About 2 weeks before the event, you will receive a Canalfest packet with your parking pass, map of the park, and your location number.

Now in its ninth year, Canalfest is three fun-filled days on the historic Erie Canal at Bellamy Harbor Park. The festival is a family-oriented event with non-stop music and entertainment, a karaoke contest, cake and bread baking contests, youth bands, fishing derby, 5K run & 2K kayak/canoe event, and even a duck race. There's something for everyone from exciting



rides for the kids and a classic car exhibition for the adults to cotton candy and raffles, all capped off by spectacular

firework displays.

Started in 2003 by the Rome Rotary Club, the festival not only provides a wonderful summer weekend activity for the whole family, but raises money for some of the community activities Rome Rotary Club sponsors including: a Christmas present, blanket, jacket, mittens and boots for over 100 local children; the Rome Rotary Scholarship; and the RFA JROTC Scholarship, to name a few.
